



The Distinguished Alumni Award is the highest award presented to an alumnus by the Metropolitan Community College Foundation. The award recognizes an alumnus who has brought honor to the College through professional achievements, leadership and community impact.

Nominations can be made by current MCC students and employees as well as community members. A nominee's name remains in contention for three years, after which the nomination may be re-submitted. The deadline to submit a nomination for the **2024** award cycle is **January 26, 2024**. Acknowledgment of nominations will be sent via email to the nominators.

The Distinguished Alumni Award winner will be honored at MCC's 2024 Commencement ceremony on **May 16, 2024**. A formal invitation will be sent to the honoree; attendance is **mandatory**. If the honoree is deceased, someone may accept the award posthumously.

HOW TO NOMINATE:

Any member of the MCC community may nominate a Metropolitan Community College alumnus by completing a nomination form. Please note that nominees remain active for three (3) years after the receipt of their nomination.

SELECTION PROCESS:

The recipient of the Distinguished Alumni Award will be decided by the MCC Foundation Board of Directors Alumni Committee. **The 2024 nomination deadline is January 26, 2024**, and the selection will be made by **February 16, 2024**. A formal invitation to commencement will be sent to the honoree.

AWARD SELECTION ELIGIBILITY:

A nominee is eligible to receive the Distinguished Alumni Award if they have received a degree or certificate from Metropolitan Community College and have met the following criteria:

1. Must be distinguished in their profession and/or community.
2. Must demonstrate outstanding contributions at MCC and/or in the community.
3. Must support MCC through: Involvement; Providing internships for MCC students; Philanthropic contributions
4. Must be a person of such integrity and stature that MCC will take pride in their recognition.

5. Two letters of support for the nominee from individuals other than the nominator;
