PUBLIC RECORDS 2.20090 BP BOARD POLICY

PURPOSE The District shall comply with Chapter 610, RSMo, the Sunshine

Law, as now existing or hereafter amended.

APPLICABILITY All records of the District shall be open to the public in a manner

required by the Sunshine Law unless otherwise permitted by law. Records of the District may be closed in any circumstance permitted by law. For purposes of this Policy, records of the Board shall be

deemed "records of the District."

CUSTODIAN OF The Chancellor shall appoint a custodian of records for the District.

RECORDS The identity and location of the custodian of records shall be availa-

The identity and location of the custodian of records shall be available to the public upon request. The custodian of records shall be responsible for responding to requests for records of the District in a time and manner consistent with the requirements of the Sunshine Law. The custodian of records may charge fees for providing access to or furnishing copies of records of the District to the extent permit-

ted by law and may waive such fees permitted by law.

POLICY This policy may be modified or revoked at any time at the sole dis-

MODIFICATION cretion of MCC's Board of Trustees.
