4.10020 BP

TUITION AND FEES

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- I. The chancellor shall recommend to the board an instructional fee per credit hour as well as student activity, technology and other fees, and a schedule of tuition for an out of district Missouri resident, an out-of-state resident, and an international resident.
- II. When the district contracts to provide education and training for the employees of an organization located within the district, the employees of this organization shall pay the fees of district residents for this education and training.
- III. Offset of Taxes Against Tuition
 - A. An out of district Missouri resident or an out of state resident may offset property and real estate taxes paid to the district for the previous year against the out of district tuition.
 - B. An out of state resident providing proof of payment of Missouri income tax may offset the out of state tuition by an amount equal to the Missouri income tax paid the previous year. The out of district Missouri resident tuition is required unless property or real estate taxes have been paid to the district.
 - C. An unempancipated minor student may offset taxes paid by a parent or legal guardian as provided in sections III. A and III.B.
- IV. The board shall set a schedule for refund of tuition and fees.
- V. The board may change tuition and fees without notice.
