Interdisciplinary honors courses for those students who demonstrate they will profit from the challenge of such courses may be offered.</p> <p>The district is authorized to develop honor, special, interdisciplinary and advances skills programs and courses in all curriculum areas.</p>
OVERSIGHT	<p>The Chief Academic Officer shall provide oversight for this policy.</p>
STUDENT HONORS PROGRAM	<p>To encourage scholarship and to recognize those students who make significant academic achievements, the district will maintain a uniform honors program. The district shall establish a procedure to recognize students who have obtained significant academic achievement.</p>
POLICY MODIFICATION	<p>This policy may be modified or revoked at any time at the sole direction of MCC's Board of Trustees.</p>
