













Average and Median Age





Unemployment Rate vs. Enrollment by Age Group









Developmental Education Credit Hours by Academic Year




Enrollment in Developmental Courses

Developmental Education Courses Success and Withdrawal Rates















FT Employees by Gender





FT Staff by Race/Ethnicity





PT Staff by Race/Ethnicity







PT Faculty Demographics by Fall Terms




