A 300/400 interdisciplinary “cluster course.” Degree requires a minimum of 36 hours at the 300/400 level, Courses taken at MCC that are equivalent to 300/400-level courses at UMKC will not be considered upper level and will not count towards the 36 minimum upper level hours that are required.
