DISTRICT INSTRUCTIONAL COORDINATING COMMITTEE

6.10040 DP

In order to maintain district-wide consistency and appropriate academic standards, the college chief academic officer will be assisted by the District Instructional Coordinating Committee (DICC).

The committee will consist of the following members:

1. College chief academic officer, the chair;
2. Deans responsible for instructional services;
3. Eight (8) academic instructional faculty from as large a variety of disciplines as possible. In addition, a total of two (2) counselors from the district, and a career and technical education faculty from each campus. Faculty shall be submitted by the Faculty Association Presidents and then nominations selected by the full Senate Executive Committee with advising input from the Vice Chancellor and then approved by the full Faculty Senate. Each campus should have at least two (2) representatives among the faculty;
4. Academic Senate President;
5. Senate Curriculum Committee chair;
6. Administrator responsible for Distance Education;
7. Chair of the District Assessment Coordinating Committee; and
8. Administrator responsible for Workforce Development

Faculty shall serve a three (3) year term, after which they may resubmit their names to Faculty Senate for nomination and continued service or relinquish their seat. Should a special service area need arise, the Vice Chancellor may request temporary faculty members be nominated by the Faculty Senate for a one (1) year term. The makeup of the committee should reflect a two-thirds faculty membership.
