A course catalog number indicates its purpose and level of difficulty.

I. Discipline Indicator

The discipline of a course will be shown by four letters preceding the course number except for any discipline having fewer than four letters.

II. Credit Courses

- A. 1-99 Courses which assist students in mastering the information skills needed for being successful in college while not meeting any degree or certificate requirements.
- B. 100-199 General courses offered as first year classes by most postsecondary institutions.
- C. 200-299 Courses offered as second year classes by most secondary institutions.
- D. 6000-7999 Continuing education courses which are vocational, occupational or public service related designed to acquire or upgrade skills relative to employment.
- E. 8000-9999 Community education courses which are vocational, recreational, or skill enhancing in nature.

III. Consistency

The vice chancellor of education and technology will be responsible for ensuring that all courses conform to this system.
