STUDENT HONORS

6.10051 DP DISTRICT PROCEDURE

PURPOSE

The student honors program recognizes students who make significant academic achievements. The district will maintain a uniform honors program in accordance with the standards of this procedure.

DEAN'S LIST

Metropolitan Community College (MCC) will issue a list of students who have achieved a semester grade point average of 3.5 at MCC. Criteria for the Dean's List are as follows:

- A. To be eligible a student must complete at least six credit hours during the semester.
- B. For each semester that a student is eligible for the college Dean's List, the distinction will be recorded on the student's transcript.

THE ASSOCIATE DEGREE WITH HONORS

To receive an Associate Degree with honors, the criteria is as follows:

- A. Students completing the requirements for an associate degree with a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or better and with no more than 21 credit hours of W will be graduated with honors.
- B. Students completing the degree requirements with a cumulative grade point average of 3.9 or better and with no more than 21 credit hours of W will be graduated with high honors.
- C. In exceptional circumstances the dean of instruction at the campus of record may waive the limit of credit hours of W permitted for graduation with honors.
- D. A minimum of 30 credit hours at MCC is required for granting honors for a degree.

HONORS CEREMONIES AND ORGANIZATIONS At the discretion of the campus president, each campus may sponsor honors organizations such as Phi Theta Kappa and arrange ceremonies to recognize student achievement.
