SERVICE ACTIVITIES OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

6.15040 BP

In providing instructional programs, the need for students to become involved in service activities may become appropriate. The chancellor is authorized to establish service activities when such activities shall be under the auspices of a student organization or shall be a district operation. The service activity shall be permitted to charge for its services and dispose of its products, if any. However, the services are being offered primarily for instructional purposes and are not intended to compete with community business.

All funds and transactions, income and expenses, shall be under the supervision of the district. In recognition of the privilege and subsidy enjoyed through such an arrangement, it is understood that all net profits shall be to the benefit of the district and the appropriate instructional program. No individual group shall profit in any tangible respect.
