## ARTICULATION

6.25040 BP

The board supports and encourages articulation with other educational institutions. Therefore, the chancellor shall develop an articulation program within the following guidelines:

- I. Secondary Schools. The district shall work in concert with the metropolitan area school districts to provide the best possible educational programs for both youths and adults. Every emphasis will be placed upon quality with equality of opportunity, while striving at all times to complement and supplement rather than to duplicate unnecessarily.
- II. Institutions of Higher Education. The district, through bilateral and multilateral agreements, shall at all times cooperate with the other colleges and universities of metropolitan Kansas City in order to provide the region's students and taxpayers with a quality education. Emphasis will be placed upon coordination of effort, facilities, equipment, curriculum, and staff, in order to avoid unilateral actions which result only in a waste of human and material resources. Again, quality with equality of opportunity must be the objective to be realized.
