Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) Criminal Justice Adult Corrections – Advising Guide

Criminal justice careers include correctional officers and jailers who guard inmates in penal, rehabilitative, or juvenile detention and may guard prisoners in transit. Probation officers help rehabilitate law offenders in custody or on probation or parole and make recommendations for treatment of offenders. Police officers enforce laws and ordinances, regulate traffic, control crowds, arrest violators and work to prevent crime.
