PATROL POSITIONS

Uniformed Foot Patrol

Responding to calls for service, crowd management, protecting property and company assets, promoting good public relations, enforcing park policies and more.

Bike/Vehicle Patrol

Provide a visible presence around company property, traffic control/management, respond to calls for service in the parking lot/around company property, vehicle escorts, and promoting good public relations.

LOSS PREVENTION/ INVESTIGATIONS POSITIONS

Undercover Security Associate

Conducts surveillance/audits/investigations relating to loss prevention, internal fraud and theft, credit card fraud activity, and criminal offenses. Identify, investigate, and interview individuals suspected of violating company policies, criminal statutes, and more.

OTHER SECURITY POSITIONS

Access Control Associate

Monitor all entry/exit points into Worlds of Fun/Oceans of Fun for guests and employees.

Dispatch Associate

Answers emergency and non-emergency phone calls and coordinates the proper response of security/law enforcement personnel as needed, monitors fire and burglar alarm systems, coordinates departmental paging in the event of emergencies, perform various clerical duties including completing dispatch log, answer guest questions, and directing telephone traffic, and more.
