





#### **Annual Unduplicated Headcount and FTE**







#### **Minority Headcount by Academic Year**







# Unemployment Rate vs. Enrollment by Age Group









#### **Developmental Education Unduplicated Headcount by Academic Year**






#### **Enrollment in Developmental Courses**









#### Trend Headcount Data for the Top Ten CTE Programs in AY 2023-2024










