
**COURSE LEVEL AGREEMENT - SESSIONS 2015/2020**

Point of entry to RGU course:	- Year 3
Conditions of entry to RGU course:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Satisfactory completion of the above named course with a minimum of 60 credits.</li> <li>- A grade point average of 3.0 or above.</li> <li>- A suitable reference from a MCKC program faculty member.</li> <li>- Where the applicants' first language is not English, satisfactory evidence that the student meets the general English language requirements of the University may be required.</li> <li>- Non-E.U. students who require a Tier 4 visa, must meet the requirements set out by the UK Visas and Immigration Secure English Language Testing (SELT) for undergraduate entry to the UK as published on their website.</li> <li>- The applicants must be eligible to obtain the requisite visa to enter the United Kingdom for study purposes.</li> </ul>

This Agreement will be reviewed every 5 years, from the date of last signing, or whenever the curriculum changes in either institution.
