



**Articulation Agreement
Between
Metropolitan Community College
and
Webster University**



Introduction

This articulation agreement formally recognizes that Webster University, hereinafter referred to as WU, and Metropolitan Community College, hereinafter referred to as MCKC, are educational institutions with a shared commitment to increasing opportunities for student access to and success in higher education. By clarifying transfer policies and procedures which assure articulation between programs, the institutions seek to assist students in making a seamless transfer from the associate to the baccalaureate degree.

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate transfer student matriculation from MCKC to WU. The attached transfer equivalency guides will describe how courses will transfer from MCKC to WU for the identified programs.

Terms & Conditions of Transfer

Students are required to meet admission requirements of WU. This agreement shall be governed by the academic policies and procedures of WU and MCKC. The evaluation and transfer of earned college credit should be in compliance with WU's guidelines and policies.

Responsibilities of Each Institution

Webster University and Metropolitan Community College will:

- Maintain the integrity of their separate programs and enter into this agreement as equal partners.
- Put the needs of the students first by serving students in the best manner possible.
- Work to promote academic success of all students by maintaining quality academic programs and institutional accreditation.
- Provide accurate and timely information to students interested in transfer to WU.
- Publicize this transfer agreement through web and printed materials and conversations with students.

Webster University will:

- Provide MCKC staff with WU materials regarding programs, admission, and enrollment.
- Conduct information sessions/workshops for MCKC students regarding admissions, financial aid, and registration.
- Host MCKC students on campus for tours and personalized appointments.

Metropolitan Community College will:

- Provide information about Webster to interested students, faculty, and counselors.
- Provide an opportunity for Webster to present to and engage with MCKC students at transfer events, college fairs, and other MCKC campus activities.

- Notify WU of significant curricular changes that will impact any transfer guide or transfer equivalency materials.

Educational Opportunities

At the Kansas City Metro location, Webster University offers the following undergraduate degree completion programs: BA Criminology, BA Management, and BA Management in Human Resources Management. The KC Metro campus also supports online undergraduate degree completion programs including the Bachelor of Science in Nursing.

Webster University, founded in 1915 with its home campus based in St. Louis, Missouri, USA, is the only Tier 1, private, nonprofit university with campus locations around the world including metropolitan, military, online and corporate, as well as American-style traditional campuses in North America, Europe, Africa, and Asia.

Webster students have an opportunity to study at any of the Webster University campuses around the world. Students may also choose to study under one of Webster’s online degree offerings.

Terms of Agreement


This agreement is made and entered into in the academic year 2016-2017 and remains in effect until discontinued with written notice by either or both institutions. The agreement may be amended at any time with the approval of both parties and is subject to regular review to assure currency with the respective degree requirements.


